



We were commissioned to create a clock feature for this destination restaurant located between Kings Cross and St Pancras railway stations in London. The design references the taste of the mid to late 1800s and nods to the building's heritage as the home from 1864 of the German Gymnastics Society. It had housed the first purpose-build gymnasium in England.

Finished in graphite black and metallic gold, it is a low-maintenance feature that will keep accurate time for decades.
